#### **Discipline Policy - 2024**

## A. Daily Inappropriate Behavior Policy

- Inappropriate Behavior Examples
  - a. Creating distractions, in particular, any distractions to or around the lifeguards
  - b. Running on the deck.
  - c. "Overzealous" and unwanted splashing of others.
  - d. Using swim noodles or other pool toys to hit others or pool property.
  - e. Excessive yelling and screaming.
  - f. Running the water in the bathrooms for no reason
  - g. Failing to follow the instructions of lifeguards and pool staff
  - h. Failing to follow pool rules relating to safety and enjoyment of pool members and guests
- 2. <u>Consequences For These Behaviors</u> may vary at the discretion of the lifeguards and pool staff. Examples may include:
  - a. First offense warning from guard.
  - b. Second offense 15 minutes sitting out.
  - c. Third offense 30 minutes sitting out and a CALL TO THE PARENT

#### B. Unacceptable Behaviors Policy

- 1. Unacceptable behavior examples
  - a. Roughhousing or any conduct that poses a safety risk to others i.e., dunking a swimmer, jumping on other swimmers.
  - b. Using profanity.
  - c. Arguing with a guard, or refusing to comply with a lifeguard's requests.
  - d. Defacing or damaging pool property or the property of others. Parent is fiscally responsible.

NOTE: For defacing or damaging pool property, the child will not be allowed to use the pool facilities for the remainder of the day. The parent/caretaker will be notified, and will be expected to make immediate arrangements to pick up the child.

# 2. Consequences For These Behaviors

- a. First offense 30 minutes sitting out and a CALL TO THE PARENT.
- b. <u>Second offense</u> child will not be allowed to use the pool facilities for the remainder of the day. The parent/caretaker will be notified, and will be expected to make immediate arrangements to pick up the child.
- C. Subsequent offenses on other days the child will not be allowed to use the pool facilities for the remainder of the day, and the parent/caretaker will be notified, and will be expected to make immediate arrangements to pick up the child. The child will no longer be allowed to come to the pool without a parent or quardian present.

Note: The Staff is not responsible for making your unaccompanied child stay on pool property. The Kemp Mill Swimming Club, Inc. is not responsible when your child leaves pool property.
